

If Fire, Police, and Ambulance agencies can't FIND you:
They can't HELP you!

Several residential and commercial buildings within the town lack proper address identification numbers. The fire code requires that all new and existing buildings have approved address identification. House and building non scripture numbers should be visible from the street and be 4 inches in height. If the building is not visible from the street, then a monument, pole, sign, or other means should be used to identify the building. Numbers should be in contrast with their background. Address identification numbers are required to be maintained by the property owner.

Making sure your home or business is properly identified can save valuable time in the event of an emergency.
